Club Players Information - Covid-19

To remain in line with current guidelines you must ensure -

- You do not attend if you are displaying any symptoms or are required to isolate. Please contact your captain ASAP so they can find a replacement player.
- You turn up ready to play as changing rooms will be shut before, during and after the game.
- You do not share equipment.
- You do not apply sweat or saliva to the ball
- You bring any food and drink you wish to consume during the game as no teas are provided.
- You always remain socially distanced, including during the game
- You comply with track and trace protocols
- You have your own supply of hand sanitiser

A reminder of our general club guidance is below. If you are selected to play away, then you may receive an additional information with guidance from that club. You must ensure you stay within the guidance to protect the good name of our club. Disciplinary measures may be taken for any reported breaches.

Please find below the specific plans and guidance we have in place at the current time -

Parking – Car parking is available on the car park or field accessed through the gate, please leave enough room between cars for social distancing.

Club Entrance – Entrance to the clubhouse is via the main door with a one-way system In operation to the toilets or clubhouse.

Club Exit – Exit from the toilets are through the back door and from the clubhouse is via the patio doors.

Changing Rooms - These will remain shut and locked during the day, so please arrive ready to start

Kit - Whilst the game is progressing, players should leave their kit safely locked in their cars

Bar – Our bar will be open from 2 August 2020 and will be serving drinks only

Teas – There will be no teas provided on the day. Please bring your own food for during the game.

Sanitiser Breaks - Take place every 6 overs or 20 minutes – whichever is sooner. The ball will be wiped down and players hands should be sanitised

Inclement Weather – In the result of delays due to rain players and spectators must return to their cars
