Free E-learning modules for Umpires

With the vast majority of the country still under lockdown and recreational cricket suspended until further notice, now is the chance to undertake some initial basic training or undertake CPD around both umpiring and scoring.

These online modules are free and are not just restricted to cricket officials and should be of an interest to everybody who has an interest in the game or wishes to take up umpiring or scoring.

1. "**Basics of Umpiring**" – This course is aimed at club umpires who just need to know the key laws and basic field craft and those players who umpire 5 or 10 overs at the weekend.

By many, he will be fondly remembered as a very fine umpire and earned the respect of cricketers of all standards. For many years he was one of the best umpires in the Minor County Championship and went on to have two years on the Reserve First Class list in the early 1980's.

During many years playing for Shropshire I was always happy to have Clive officiating as one knew the match would be in safe hands. His ability, sense of humour and the respect in which he was held by players, guaranteed any tensions that may have arisen were quickly diffused.

His passing will be felt by many cricketers, particularly of my generation, not only in Shropshire but throughout the country where he had umpired.
