



## **GUIDANCE FOR HODNET & PELOW PLAYERS** **TRAVELLING AWAY**

Dear Player,

In these strange times, all clubs are taking precautions to help everyone stay safe. It is important you comply, in good spirit, with all their instructions no matter how petty they may seem. Remember everyone is doing their best to keep each other safe and some clubs will do things differently than others.

1. All players must self-screen for Covid-19 before travelling and must not leave home if you have any symptoms. Please contact your Captain immediately in the event of feeling unwell
2. Go the game in your kit as changing rooms will not be available
3. Take your own hand sanitiser with you and we suggest, some sanitiser wipes
4. Take your own tea with you, it will not be provided
5. Plan your travel beforehand to comply with the rules
6. We will send to you any guidelines we receive from other clubs, please read these and ensure you abide by them.
7. Hand sanitiser should be used every 6 overs
8. Sanitiser wipes will be available for fielding Captain to wipe ball every 6 overs
9. If you are bowling straight after a break make sure your hands and the ball, are dry
10. Fielders to return ball directly to bowler
11. Sanitise your bat after your innings, no matter how short!
12. Only umpires to touch stumps and bails which will be sanitised between innings
13. Markers 2m parallel to square will show where non striker should stand and run
14. Should you develop symptoms following the game please contact your Captain immediately
15. We are obliged by the ECB guidance to point out that there is an increased risk of transmission of the virus by participating in even socially distanced group activity and by playing in the upcoming game, you accept that risk

**Above all please use common sense and look after each other.**

If you have any questions when at the ground please speak to the opposing Captain or Club Official and make sure you thank them for looking after you before you leave.
