Match scorer(s)	Match score person(s) / Risk of infection	Separate table and area provided for scorer during play. Social distancing adhered to. Where 2 scores are present, they will each have their own area.
Inclement weather	All players, spectators / Risk of infection.	Changing rooms to remain closed to minimise risk of indoors virus transmission
