

Forton CC Guidance for Match Play during Covid-19

No person to travel to Forton CC if displaying Covid Symptoms.

Parking & Spectators

All players, officials and spectators, will be directed to their designated parking areas.

Spectators to remain in their designated areas. Main gate must kept clear for emergency vehicles.

Contact Information

Upon arrival, all players, officials and visitors will need to give their Contact Details to the Club Representative, as required be ECB Guidelines (these will be destroyed after 21 days).

We are also obliged by the ECB to point out there is an increased rik of transmitting the virus by participating even socially distanced group activity and by playing in the upcoming game you accept that risk. You will be asked to sign a disclaimer to this end.

Clubhouse Facilities and Toilets

Clubhouse will be closed unless there is an emergency when supervision will be provided.

All persons should use toilet facilities at home before travel.

Toilet facility is available in Home Changing Room should the need arise.

Equipment/Cleaning and Changes to Square.

All Players and Officials must come dressed ready for play as Changing Room is closed.

All persons must bring own equipment, plus gloves and sanitiser.

Cricket Balls to be sanitised between overs. Hand sanitiser will be available on clubhouse wall and boundary benches for use every six overs.

Sanitiser Wipes will be available for Fielding Captain to wipe the ball every six overs.

Only Umpires to touch Stumps and bails.

Fielder should return ball directly to bowler.

Markers 2m parallel to square will show where non-striker should stand and run.

Refreshments

ALL persons must provide their own refreshments to maintain sugar/fluid levels.

Safeguarding Awareness

Everyone to be aware of Safeguarding Procedures at all times. Due to varying abilities, it may be

necessary to mix Adults and Juniors.

Medical Care

First Aid Kits are available at all times. Clubhouse will be available for emergency use.

Accident Forms to be completed fully after any incident.
