Opposition Information - Covid-19

Dear Opposition

We welcome you to Albrighton Cricket Club. Please find below the specific plans and guidance we have in place to ensure all of our players, spectators and volunteers remain safe, in line with the ECB's guidance:

Symptoms – Please remind all your players/spectators not to attend if they display any symptoms or are required to isolate. If symptoms develop during the game, then please follow published guidelines

Parking – Car parking is available on the car park or field accessed through the gate, please leave enough room between cars for social distancing.

Club Entrance – Entrance to the clubhouse is via the main door with a one-way system in operation to the toilets or clubhouse.

Club Exit – Exit from the toilets are through the back door and from the clubhouse is via the patio doors.

Changing Rooms – These will remain shut and locked during the day, please encourage your players to arrive changed and ready to play. Should your players need room to put on protective equipment please tell us and this can be arranged.

Kit – Whilst the game is progressing, players should leave their kit safely locked in their cars

Bar – Our bar will be open from 2 August 2020 and will be serving drinks only

Teas – There will be no teas provided on the day. Please bring your own food for during the game.

Sanitiser Breaks - Take place every 6 overs or 20 minutes – whichever is sooner. The ball will be wiped down and players hands should be sanitised

Inclement Weather – In the result of delays due to rain players and spectators must return to their cars

Spectators – We welcome spectators, however, please remind them to socially distance and to not touch the ball at any time. Please remind them to sanitise their hands regularly.

Conduct – Please ask all players and spectators to respect the above points and comply with our test and trace procedure. If anybody (from either side) does not comply with our guidance they may be asked to leave the club.
