



## GUIDANCE FOR UMPIRES VISITING WORFIELD CRICKET CLUB 2021

Dear Umpire,

We look forward to welcoming you to Davenport Park.

In these strange times, we have taken all precautions in terms of risk assessment, cleaning, sanitising etc and please find following some guidance to make your visit as enjoyable as possible:

1. All players and officials must self-screen for Covid-19 before travelling and must not leave home if they have any symptoms
2. Car Park open as normal
3. Pavilion and changing rooms will be closed (apart from access to toilets) throughout
4. Hand sanitiser will be available on benches on both side of square around boundary for use every 6 overs
5. Sanitiser wipes will be available for fielding Captain to wipe ball every 6 overs
6. Please ensure bowlers hands and the ball are dry before resuming after a sanitising break
7. Only Umpires to touch stumps and bails (at their end only) which will be sanitised between innings
8. Markers 2m parallel to square will show where non-striker should stand and run
9. Fielder should return ball directly to bowler
10. Spectators should not touch ball in any circumstances
11. Scorers will be sited in or to side of Pavilion and will use the electronic scoreboard opposite
12. In the event of rain ECB guidance should be followed and umpires should shelter in their cars.
13. A First Aid kit, including disposable gloves, is located in the Kitchen
14. A defibrillator is located on the external wall, far side of the Equipment Shed
15. Sadly, the bar will not be open and there will be no teas. Umpires are advised to bring their own
16. Should you develop any symptoms following the game please contact me immediately and we will, of course, do the same
17. We are obliged by the ECB guidance to point out that there is a slightly increased risk of transmission of the virus by participating in even socially distanced group activity and by umpiring in the upcoming game, you accept that risk

We have also sent you a copy of the guidance sent to the visitors.

**Above all we ask everyone to apply common sense and look after each other.**
